Founded on September 15, 2003, the Chamber of Commerce and Industry Brazil - Iran acts as an agent to encourage cooperation between the competent authorities and business associations of both countries.

Its objectives are to provide assistance to its members in matters pertaining to commercial, industrial, technical and financial relationship between Brazil and Iran, providing information to facilitate the completion of business between the two countries.

Added to this, the organization cherishes to promote understanding and cooperation between Brazil and Iran, to promote industry and commerce in technological, scientific, economic and cultural, aiming to strengthen and develop ties with the Islamic republic.

The Chamber of Commerce and Industry Brazil - Iran is affiliated with the Commercial Association of Rio de Janeiro (ACRJ) the oldest civil representation authority of the country fulfilling the role of being the best place in Rio de Janeiro to do business and the Federation the Foreign Chambers of Commerce (FCCE) the oldest trade association in Brazil dedicated exclusively to the activities of the Foreign Trade.

In September 2015, the Chamber of Commerce and Industry Brazil - Iran renewed affiliation with the Federation of Foreign Trade Chambers (FCCE), creating a network throughout the country with its regional officials.
